#### **GUIDELINES OF EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION FOR CLASS 8**

(w.e.f. 2023-2024 onwards)

CBSE vide its **Circular No. ACAD-57/2022** dated 20.05.2022 has **restored the Board Exams to the pre-pandemic format, making the Exams ONE phased ONLY**. The Board has, constantly, been initiating further corresponding changes in the Examinations and Assessments Practices also to **align assessment to Competency Based Education (CBE) in line of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.** 

With restoration of Board Examinations to the pre-pandemic format and also keeping in view the provisions of Right to Education Act, 2009, the DoE-Govt. of NCT of Delhi with the recommendation of SCERT vide its ORDER No. DE.5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/717-727 dated 07.10.2022 has introduced New Guidelines for Examination and Promotion for Std. 8 from this Session i.e. 2023-2024 onwards.

#### **GUIDELINES OF EXAMINATION**

- Regular Assessment of the students will be done throughout the Academic Session, through Periodic Tests, Mid Term Exam and Annual Exam.
- Each Periodic Test will be of 30 Marks while Mid Term and Annual Exams will be of 60 Marks each.
- Duration of Periodic test will be 75 minutes whereas the duration for Mid Term and Annual Examinations will be 2 Hrs. 30 Minutes.
- The Question Paper for Mid Term Exam will be set out of the syllabus of the First term. The Question Paper for Annual Exam will be set out of the syllabus of both First and Second Term.

#### PASSING CRITERIA FOR CLASS 8

- In order to be declared `PASS' at the end of the session for promotion to the next class, a student must score at least 33% marks in each subject.
- The Promotion to the next higher class is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Annual Exam i.e. 15 marks out of 60 in each subject.

#### **RE-EXAMINATION FOR CLASS 8**

- If a student is unable to appear for Annual Exam, he/ she will have to appear for Re-Exam.
- A student who has appeared in the Annual exam is required to appear in Re-Exam in all the failing subjects.
- Re-Exam will be conducted on the same syllabus and pattern as the Annual Exam i.e. 2 Hrs. 30 Minutes duration and 60 Marks.
- If a student does not secure at least 25% marks in the subject in which he/ she has appeared for Re-Exam and a minimum of 33 out of 100 in that subject,

OR

• If a student does not appear in Re-Exam, then he/ she will be placed in the category of 'ESSENTIAL REPEAT' (ER) and will be held back in the same class.

#### **ATTENDANCE CRITERIA FOR CLASS 8**

- A student will not be eligible to appear in Annual Exam if he/ she doesn't have at least 75% attendance calculated from the beginning of the session/ Date of Admission till the date of Annual Exam.
- Internal Assessment will include 5 Marks for attendance.
